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*Takeaway* **Learnings**

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- Previously, a glaring gap between learning objectives and outcomes was the norm. Now with the NEP, both these factors have become demonstrable, observable, and measurable.
- Classrooms must not only support learning but practice for the world beyond the campus.
- Learning outcomes in schools are now matching societal needs.
- A basket of objectives cannot define a class of students. Each ward is as different as are their learning styles. Teachers have to gauge these features and malleate the process.
