Eligibility & Requirements for Admissions at Vijaybhoomi University

For admission in all undergraduate degree programmes as listed below, meeting the cut off score in the prescribed entrance tests for UG as listed in the table below and ASP is a bare essential requirement. However, for a decision of scholarship, the VUSAT score along with scores in national and state level examinations identified by the Admissions Committee may be considered:
