

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


Late Shri V. B. Padode Founder, Vijaybhoomi University

The curriculum and pedagogy revolve around self-discovery, anchored in the liberal education framework. The first-year experience promotes exposure to multiple disciplines, while later years enable students to select courses aligned with their professional aspirations.

Leadership Insights

While many institutions reconsidered their philosophies in light of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, Vijaybhoomi University, established in 2019, was ahead in aligning its educational philosophy with NEP recommendations, emerging as a frontrunner in implementation.







Kanyathon

Kanyathon is a student-led initiative that began in 2011 with the mission of supporting and empowering underprivileged girls in India. Centered around a marathon, Kanyathon has evolved into a significant platform for raising awareness and funds to improve the lives of girls through education, health, and community development initiatives. The term "Kanya," meaning "girl" in English, symbolizes solidarity and support for girls in need across India.

Vision and Mission

Vision: To create a sustainable model that addresses gender inequality by empowering girls from underprivileged backgrounds through education and skill development.

Mission: To uplift and support young girls and women, ensuring access to resources, education, and opportunities necessary for their growth. Initiatives include the Kanyathon Shiksha Kendra, a digital literacy center dedicated to educating young women in rural areas, along with providing scholarships to meritorious girls.

Student and Curriculum Integration

Kanyathon transcends being merely a charity event; it is seamlessly integrated into the academic experience of students. The event is organized with a corporate-style structure, featuring defined roles such as President, Vice President, Marketing Head, Operations Manager, and Finance Head. This setup enables students to contribute to a noble cause while acquiring practical skills in leadership, project management, and teamwork. Participation in Kanyathon is also part of the academic curriculum, allowing students to earn academic credits for their involvement. This hands-on experience enhances their holistic development.

Kanyathon 2024: Registrations and Participation

In March 2024, Kanyathon achieved a record turnout, with 11,235 registrations and a footfall of 10,600 participants from JAGSoM, IFIM, and Vijaybhoomi University, including over 3000 participants from Vijaybhoomi University alone. The event successfully raised a total of INR 64,41,510, underscoring its impact and the dedication of both students and the community.

Kanyathon

Kanyathon Impact

The funds raised from Kanyathon 2024 have been utilized for several impactful initiatives:

Nine scholarships were awarded to meritorious and economically weaker section girls' students of IFIM and Vijaybhoomi University to support their education.

Established and operating Kanyathon Shiksha Kendras, which are digital smart classrooms providing computer skills and spoken English training. These classrooms are currently active in one school in Jambrung, three in the Kolar district, and one in Tirupalya, Bangalore.

Adopted fifteen daughters from the red-light district of Kamathipura and Budhwar Peth, Pune (in collaboration with the NGOs- Mumbai Smiles and Sparsh) to ensure their safety, education, and holistic development.

Kanyathon continues to be a driving force in uplifting underprivileged girls, significantly contributing to the creation of a more equitable and educated society.



Social Immersion Program

Social Immersion Program (SIP) at Vijaybhoomi University is an innovative practice course aimed at connecting academic knowledge with practical social engagement. Under the leadership of Prof. Nitesh Kumar and Dr. Abhinita Mohanty in 2024, the program equips students with valuable hands-on experience, exposing them to critical social issues while fostering community involvement.

Through SIP, students can apply their theoretical knowledge in real-world contexts, enhancing their professional skills and making a positive impact on society. This initiative uniquely blends academic learning with practical experiences in social settings, encouraging collaboration among educational institutions, community organizations, and businesses. Students participate in immersive field visits to rural and semi-urban areas for durations ranging from 8 to 20 days, where they identify various social challenges and propose sustainable, technology-driven solutions.

Objectives of SIP

- Sensitize students to social issues and sustainable business practices.
- Develop critical thinking, problem-solving, teamwork, and communication skills through real-world experiences.
- Foster social responsibility and ethical leadership among students.
- Establish long-term partnerships between academic institutions and community organizations.

Highlights

- In 2024, students made notable contributions through their collaboration with IndiaHikes in Manali, focusing on environmental sustainability and preserving the natural ecosystem. Another group partnered with the Rotary Foundation in Mumbai to support entrepreneurship initiatives.
- Students engaged with organizations like Asha Foundation in Pune and Light of Life in Karjat, gaining valuable insights into educational and skill development challenges.
- Additionally, new Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) were established with Samagra Foundation, Teach for India (Pune), Aayush Nilayam (Hyderabad), Kind Beings (New Delhi), and Seva Sahyog (Pune) to enhance future SIP collaborations.
- Throughout the program, students tackled various social issues, presenting their findings and practical solutions in detailed reports and dissertations over two semesters.

Social Immersion Program

Impact of SIP

- 76 students worked with 9 organizations as part of the 2024 SIP (Social Immersion Program), making a significant impact.
- Field Research & Inputs: Students conducted field research, providing NGOs with valuable input and implementation strategies to overcome challenges.
- Samagra Foundation: Students visited slum areas to understand challenges from a community-based perspective, focusing on sustainable development rather than a top-down approach.
- India Hikes: Students developed a strategy for sustainable waste management, showcasing their ability to create impactful environmental solutions.
- Kind Beings (Delhi): Students identified the need for sustainable funding sources and proposed integrating campaigns with technological tools to enhance impact.
- Teach for India (Pune): Students implemented innovative teaching techniques, such as using free mobile digital audio stations for hands-on music training programs.
- Seva Sahayog (NGO): Addressed challenges in vocational training and women empowerment programs, suggesting training for educators and strategies to improve market access for products.
- Rotary Foundation (Mumbai): Students expanded support for Chikooli, a local snack brand, partnering with Kush Sheth's startup for better outreach, student also proposed a supply chain framework to improve agricultural branding and empower local women farmers.

The 2024 SIP included evaluations from various NGOs and virtual participation during student presentations. Orientation sessions conducted by the Chair and Co-chair covered research ethics, field conduct, and report submission formats.





Community Impact

Community Support

In July 2023, following a dam leakage in Karjat, Maharashtra, Vijaybhoomi University collaborated with government authorities to provide shelter and ensure the safety of residents from the neighboring Solanpada village who were evacuated from their homes. The university's campus served as a refuge, and the team worked diligently to assist in the evacuation process, demonstrating a strong commitment to community support.

The For Not For (FNF) competition is an annual international debate event hosted by Vijaybhoomi University. This event is designed to engage young people in discussions on global issues, promoting awareness of liberal education. The debate format includes online elimination rounds, while the finale and semifinals take place offline at Vijaybhoomi Campus.

Over 100 students from various schools around the world, including countries such as Bhutan, India, Nepal, and Dubai, participate in this competition. The event features two categories: the Senior Category for grades 11-12 and the Junior Category for grades 9-10.

The prize money for the competition is significant, with the first prize amounting to \$1,000 (Rs. 85,000) and the second prize totaling \$500 (Rs. 45,000).

In the Senior Category, the first position was secured by Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Vihar with participants Avdhesh Dubey and Shreshtha Sharma. The second position went to Cambridge Court High School, represented by Pehal Chopra and Rupashi Singh Baghel.
