Convocation 2024-25

The **6th Convocation Ceremony** at Vijaybhoomi University was celebrated on **March 11, 2025**; with **Mr. Uday Deshpande - Padma Shree Awardee** gracing the occasion as the Chief Guest.

Jagdish Sheth School of Management (JAGSoM)

- JAGSoM Signed the MoU with University of Texas for Undergraduate International Pathway Exchange Program.
- Faculty achieved significant publication success, including 13 SCOPUS-listed journal publications (Dr. Arindam Ghosh: 11; Dr. Anirrban Ghosh: 2) and research papers in UGC care journals.
- The highest stipend achieved was ₹85,000 for the MBA Batch and 5 students got final placement in above 15 Lakhs bracket.

Vijaybhoomi School of Science & Technology (VSST)

- Student enrollment in the B.Tech
 Computer Science (AI) program rose
 significantly in AY 2024 (53 students),
 reflecting the strong demand for this
 specialized program.
- VSST faculty and students worked on real-time Agentic AI models for e-Governance with the Government of Maharashtra's Tribal Development Department and the Revenue Department (Konkan).
- Collaborated with E-Cell, IIT Bombay, to host the national-level Hackathon, ELEVATE-2024, which garnered 1,450+ online registrations and 90,000+ impressions.
- Rahul Purohit,2nd year student, secured 2nd position at the National-level Google Cloud Agentic AI Hackathon, winning a cash prize of ₹2,00,000.

- Kush Sheth, a student of VSST, successfully established his venture ProjektAnalytics Pvt. Ltd., secured incubation at NSRCEL, IIM Bangalore, and has already begun generating clients and revenue.
- Build Your Own Robots: A robotics workshop was conducted where participants designed, built, and programmed their own robots.

Vijaybhoomi School of Design (VSoD)

- School Of Design conducted a masterclass/workshop on 'D3.Js Information Visualisation-data values to charts' on May 9, 2024.
- Dean of the Design School conducted a "Fine Arts Research" workshop in the Netherlands (August 2024), bringing international experience back to the school.
- 2 students from the final batch (100%)
 have converted their internship to PPOs
 (Pre-Placement Offers).

Vijaybhoomi School of Law (VSoL)

- Faculty published 10 scholarly works, including 5 papers in international/peer-reviewed journals.
- One final year student secured a placement as a Legal & Compliance Officer at Garuda Chala Pvt. Ltd. with a package of ₹8.5 LPA.

- Students held key leadership roles, including Student Council President (Adith Iyer) and Vice President, DORF (Riya Khedekar).
- Students completed 12 legal and social impact internships with organizations including Allahabad High Court, Bayer CropScience India, Civil Court, and various NGOs.
- Hosted visits from legal experts, including Dr. Jayita Moulick (Professor, Symbiosis Pune) and Dr. Amitabh Gawale (High Court Lawyer specializing in NDPS Act).
- One student of 4th year has founded a startup in the legal area - Rights-Guard, integrating AI with Intellectual Property Rights.

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 Implementation

Vijaybhoomi University has been aligning its academic framework with the UGC and Maharashtra State guidelines for NEP 2020, including the Government Resolution dated 6th December 2022. The University resolved to implement NEP 2020 in letter and spirit from AY 2020-21. Key features implemented at Vijaybhoomi University, Karjat, include:

- Adoption of a flexible and multidisciplinary academic structure enabling students to design their learning pathways through combinations of major and minor disciplines.
- Introduction of Ability Enhancement, Skill Enhancement, Value-Added, and Practice-Based Courses that emphasize holistic development through initiatives such as the Personality Enhancement Program (PEP), Research Incubation (RI), Social Immersion Program (SIP), Effective Execution (EE), and Industry Internship Program (IIP).
- Implementation of the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) to facilitate seamless credit accumulation and transfer, and updated upto 2025.
- Introduction of Multiple Entry and Exit Options, allowing students the flexibility to pursue education at their own pace and goals. A couple of students have also taken admission as lateral entry.
- Establishment of a Credit Transfer Policy to ensure smooth academic mobility across higher education institutions.
- Comprehensive Assessment Reforms focusing on continuous and formative evaluation rather than reliance on high-stakes examinations.
- Implementation of Criterion-Based Grading and Outcome-Based Education (OBE) across all programs to ensure measurable and competency-driven learning outcomes.

Dr. Kasturirangan, Chairman of the NEP 2020 Drafting Committee, visited the Vijaybhoomi University campus in 2023. He appreciated the University's distinctive model of integrating multiple schools within a holistic ecosystem and was deeply impressed by the diverse and multidisciplinary approach embedded in its curriculum.

University Status on NAAC

Vijaybhoomi University, Karjat, has approached to apply for NAAC accreditation, however because of change in the methodology we have been asked to wait till further notification. An Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been established, and the University is preparing to submit the Self-Study Report (SSR) as soon as the NAAC office releases new notifications.

Key Initiatives to Enhance Quality Education

Vijaybhoomi University is committed to providing holistic education that nurtures intellectual, emotional, physical, and ethical growth. With an interdisciplinary and experiential learning framework enriched by STEM education and strong industry collaborations, the University equips students with future-ready skills and an innovative mindset. Continuous curriculum enhancement and personality development initiatives further strengthen academic quality, fostering well-rounded, socially conscious leaders. Some of the key initiatives undertaken to enhance the quality of education include:

- Liberal-Professional Curriculum that blends broad-based learning with specialization to develop T-shaped professionals.
- **Experiential Learning:** Includes Research Incubation, Social Immersion Program, Industry Internships, and Personality Enhancement Programs.

Research Incubation

Overview

The Research Incubation (RI) program at Vijaybhoomi University is designed to equip students with critical thinking and problemsolving skills. In a 3-year UG program, students can register for an RI course after completing one and a half years and 60 credits.  e. Oral dissemination of research information.
 f. Written dissemination of research information.
- 3. To train students to evaluate the relative effectiveness of alternative solutions for addressing the problem(s).

Industry Internship Program (IIP)

Overview

The Industry Internship Program is an essential practice course for all students at Vijaybhoomi University, regardless of their degree program. The program bridges classroom learning with practical, actionable application in the industry through internships. During the internship, students gain knowledge of corporate structures and business operations.

Objectives

The key objectives of the Industry Internship Program include:

- Understanding corporate structure and professional etiquette.
- Visualizing situations in the context of problems defined by the organization.
- Articulating problems appropriately within the organizational context.
- Formally defining problems, evaluating alternatives, and recommending feasible solutions that satisfy all stakeholders and functional areas.

- Implementing, presenting, and defending solutions both orally and in writing.
- Applying classroom learnings in realworld industry settings.

Curriculum Integration

The Industry Internship Program is delivered as a 10-credit practice course, pursued in two parts:

- A 2-credit (1.5-month) short internship during one of the summer breaks after the Colours Terms (generally in the 2nd or 3rd Colours Term of a 4-year degree).
- An 8-credit, 6-month internship (on-thejob training) following the completion of all other curricular requirements, serving as the final course in the student's academic journey at Vijaybhoomi University. This internship typically constitutes the last two terms of a 4-year degree.

Startup Initiatives

Kush Sheth (B.Tech AI, 2021–2025), along with his team, launched ProjektAnalytics Pvt. Ltd. under the prestigious startup incubation program at NSRCEL, IIM Bangalore. The company has reported its first revenue figures and is serving multiple clients both in India and abroad. ProjektAnalytics focuses on providing data-driven insights to enterprises, with a special emphasis on explainability.

 Established 5 digital learning hubs in government schools, benefiting 300+ students with English and computer literacy training.
- Menstrual Hygiene Awareness:
 Distributed reusable sanitary napkins to 500 girls and organized health sessions, empowering them with knowledge and sustainable hygiene practices.
- with Akshaya Patra Foundation and ELCIA Trust to provide a year of nutritious mid-day meals to students at a KSK in Bangalore.

- Stationery Donation: Supplied educational resources to Adivasi children and KSK students, nurturing creativity and supporting their academic growth.
- Computer Donation: Equipped Wilson School and KSKs with computers, enabling digital literacy and practical technology training for underserved students.
- eco-friendly practices by planting trees under the Plant4Guru campaign and distributing steel water bottles to reduce single-use plastic.
- Summer Camp: Kanyathon hosted a one-month free summer camp (20th May,25 - 20th June,25) for 20 girls from Jambrung and nearby villages, offering activities such as sports, art, English communication, Canva training, and health sessions. The camp aimed to enhance their skills, creativity, and confidence while fostering overall growth.





Social Immersion Program (SIP)

The Social Immersion Programme (SIP) is a unique initiative designed to integrate academic learning with real-world experiences in social contexts. It involves collaboration between educational institutions, community organizations, and businesses to provide students with handson learning and community engagement opportunities.

Students should complete 40 credits of coursework at the University or attend two full terms of study to be eligible for SIP program. SIP must be completed before enrolling in any other practice courses.

Objectives

- Sensitize students to social issues, community development, and sustainable business practices.
- Develop critical thinking, problemsolving, teamwork, and communication skills.
- Foster social responsibility and ethical leadership.
- Establish long-term partnerships between the academic institution and community organizations.

Activities Undertaken

This year's Social Immersion Program provided a unique and impactful opportunity for 104 students to step beyond the classroom and apply their skills in real-world settings. Partnering with 15 different nongovernmental organizations (NGOs), the

program not only offered students a firsthand look at the critical work being carried out in various communities but also enabled them to provide valuable support to these organizations in their core daily functions. Each group was accompanied by a faculty mentor and received periodic supervision from the SIP Chair and Co-Chair.

Overview

For Not For (FNF) is an annual flagship debate competition hosted by Vijaybhoomi University to foster critical thinking, articulate expression, and a liberal mindset among young learners. Aligned with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), the competition engages participants in thought-provoking discussions on global issues, encouraging respectful exchange of diverse perspectives. Till 2024, FNF was an international interschool debate competition; from 2025 onwards, it has evolved into a full-fledged international debate competition, opening its platform to a wider range of participants.

Purpose

FNF aims to provide a platform for youth to deliberate on pressing global challenges, promoting free and open expression of thought while building awareness around the value of liberal education.

Format & Scope

FNF follows an international-style debate format, typically conducted in a hybrid model-with preliminary rounds held online and final rounds hosted at the Vijaybhoomi University campus. The event attracts participation from reputed national and international institutions and is judged by distinguished academics and professionals.

In the run-up to the main event, Vijaybhoomi University hosts Initium, a preparatory program featuring workshops and training sessions to help participants refine their debating skills, boost confidence, and develop deeper insights into the topics.

FutureConnect


