

Rahul Purohit Excels at the National AI Olympiad



Rahul Purohit, a second-year student at the Vijaybhoomi School of Science and Technology, delivered an impressive performance at the National AI Olympiad (Advanced Category). Encouraged by his mentor Dr. Salur Srikant Patnaik, Rahul approached the challenge with a strong focus on fundamentals, logical thinking, and consistent practice. His disciplined preparation paid off, earning him a score of 54/70 (77.14%), a State Rank of 24 in Maharashtra, and a National Rank of 179.

Beyond the rankings, the experience strengthened Rahul's confidence and problem-solving approach, highlighting the transformative impact of mentorship and perseverance on academic growth.

Phantom Harmonics Masterclass at True School of Music

Why "doing" beats waiting in the age of AI

Gen Z undergrads are stepping into a job market that doesn't behave like a syllabus. AI is rewriting workflows faster than universities can update curricula. Roles appear, mutate, and disappear within a single degree cycle. In this churn, one question keeps surfacing in classrooms and hostel rooms alike: *How do I become market-ready before the market changes again?*

The old answer was the internship. The new, more powerful answer is the side hustle.
