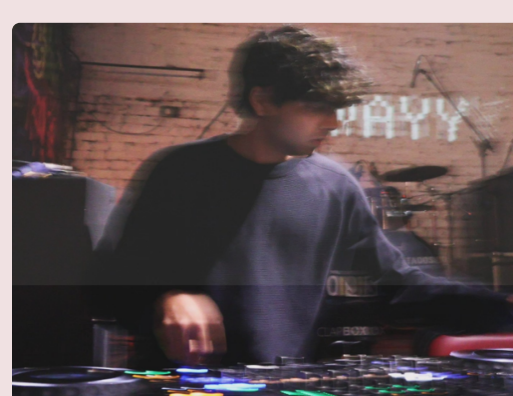
Backed by a full live ensemble and an engaged audience, the performance felt immersive, warm, and celebratory, the perfect beginning to the night.
