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1. Introduction:

Vijaybhoomi University (VU) is India's first liberal professional university, which aspires to offer relevant and quality professional education and engages in high-quality research. Our university, based in Karjat, Raigad, is devoted to nurturing holistic, socially responsible, and continuously employable professionals who make a positive difference in the world.

In line with our vision, we are committed to excellence in admissions, and to ensure that our procedures are fair and transparent. We welcome applications from all aspiring candidates with the potential to succeed.

Admissions practices at VU are designed to ensure that applications are considered based on applicants' merit and potential to successfully complete their programme of study.

The VU admission process will be spearheaded by Admissions Committee as set out in this policy and process document. Any exception to the process is to be cleared by the Exceptions Committee chaired by the Vice Chancellor.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- For admission in all undergraduate degree programs, meeting the cut off score in the prescribed entrance tests and ASP is a bare essential requirement unless otherwise defined in the handbook.
- For UG programs at VU, the eligibility criteria to take admission in any of the UG program is the candidate must have cleared class 12th with a minimum of 50% marks overall. In exceptional conditions, Admission Committee may decide to offer remedial courses in lieu of the shortfall in meeting the requirement of 50 percent in 12th class with the approval of the VC.
- For scholarships, the below mentioned scores are required.
 - 80 and above in CLAT
 - 440 and above in LSAT
 - 90 and above in MHCET
 - 180 and above in IPMAT
 - 60 percent and above in PERA CET
 - 600 and above in CUET
 - 100 and above (cumulative in Part A and B) in UCEED
 - 55 and above in NID DAT
 - Must have cleared IIT mains

4.1 UG ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- For IGCSE & Cambridge Board Marks, the following table need to be used for converting grades to percentages and the Grade Points based on the computed percentages can be assigned using the table for Indian Board Examinations
- For IBDP a minimum score of 24 is required. CAS requirements are met. All subjects have been graded including TOK and the EE.
- For IBCP, the criteria laid down by Association of Indian Universities will be followed for all undergrad admissions.

4.2 PG ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- For PG programs at VU, the eligibility criteria to take admission in any of the PG program is that the candidate must have cleared final year of graduation from any stream with a minimum of 50% marks overall.

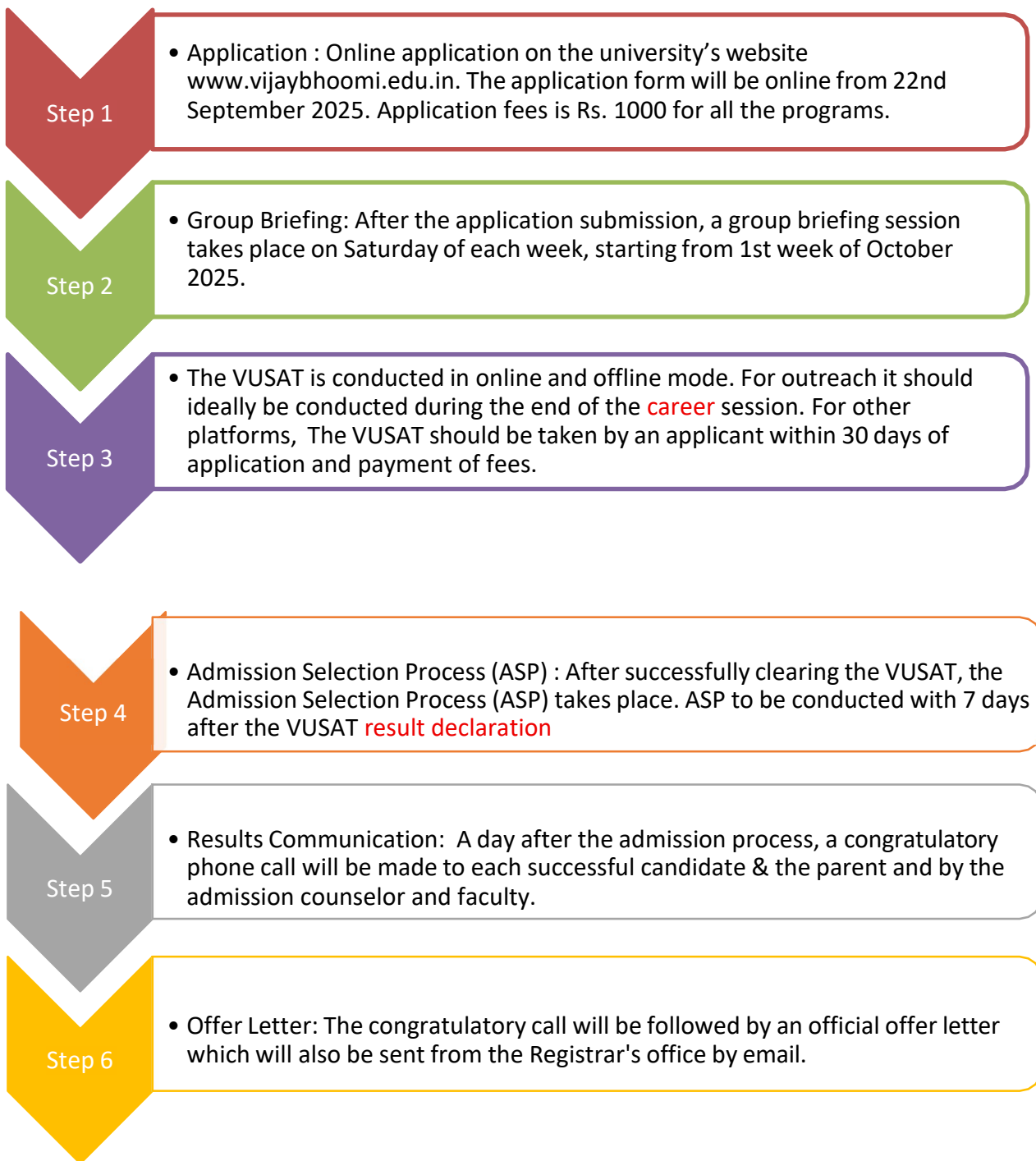

- For School of Design:
 - Apart from the above route through VU-SAT, the candidate may also seek admission to the School of Design based on submission of a portfolio followed by interaction with School as per the norms of the University.
- For school of Music:
 - Apart from the above route through VU-SAT, the candidate may also seek admission to the School of Music based on submission of a portfolio followed by interaction with School as per the norms of the University.
- The decision solely lies with the Dean of respective schools.

5. ADMISSION PROCESS

5.1 ADMISSION PROCESS FLOWCHART



Step 7

- Acceptance of Offer: To secure the admission, the students are required to accept the offer within fifteen days of receiving the offer letter. This acceptance is confirmed by paying the registration fee of Rs. 100,000 (out of which Rs. 25,000 is for the welcome kit, which is non-refundable and rest Rs. 75000 is part of fee), and serves as an official confirmation of the student's intent to enroll at the university. The registration amount will be suitably modified as per the terms and conditions of a scholarship.

Step 8

- Welcome kit : On receipt of the registration fee, a welcome kit will be dispatched to the student, with formal intimation from Registrar's Office.

The admission process starts with an online application on the university's website www.vijaybhoomi.edu.in. **The application form will be online from 22nd September 2025.**

5.2 Group Briefing:

- After the application submission, a group briefing session takes place on Saturday of each week, starting from **1st week of October 2025**. During this session, the students who have applied will meet with key university personnel such as the Director-Admissions, Registrar / VC or Deans. The briefing will introduce the students to the Philosophy and Vision of the University. It will also cover aspects of what to expect from VUSAT as well as an overview of the Admission Selection Process (ASP) and other relevant information.

5.3 VUSAT:

- The VUSAT is conducted both offline and online. The test link will be generated automatically for each student. The different links will be provided to the students appearing on a particular day. The VUSAT should be taken by an applicant **within 30 days** of application and payment of fees. Offline VUSAT's are conducted on the discretion of the university and cannot be requested by the student.
- Students applying to the School of Music or School of Design can submit their portfolio in place of the VUSAT.

In case;

- The applicant clears the VUSAT, **the admission counselor** will call the student to congratulate the applicant and the admission- Director/Admission team member will call the parent to congratulate them on their ward's success. Post that the admission counselor will help the applicant prepare for the ASP as per a pointer provided. Also prior to the ASP, **the admission counselor** will call up the applicant and will brief about the process of ASP along with confirmation on the date and the last-minute checks with CC to Registrar's Office.

5.4 Admission Selection Process (ASP):

- After successfully clearing the VUSAT, the Admission Selection Process (ASP) takes place. The ASP involves a panel created by the Registrar comprising of all deans from different schools within the university. These weekly ASPs are calendared and assigned faculty from each school are available. The panel carefully evaluates the students' VUSAT scores, along with other relevant criteria, such as academic achievements, extracurricular activities, and recommendations. The ASP ensures a comprehensive assessment of each student's suitability for admission. A written letter by mail will also be dispatched to the students and parents from the Registrar's office informing them about the success and providing information about steps moving forward.

5.5 Results Communication:

- A day after the admission process, a congratulatory phone call will be made to each successful candidate & the parent and **by the admission counselor** with regard to their admission and applicable scholarships, **if any**, they may have been awarded.

5.6 Offer Letter:

- The congratulatory call will be followed by an official offer letter which will also be sent from the Registrar's office by email. The offer letter should provide all the necessary details related to the admission, including the program of study, tuition fees, bank account details, any conditions or requirements, and the deadline for acceptance. 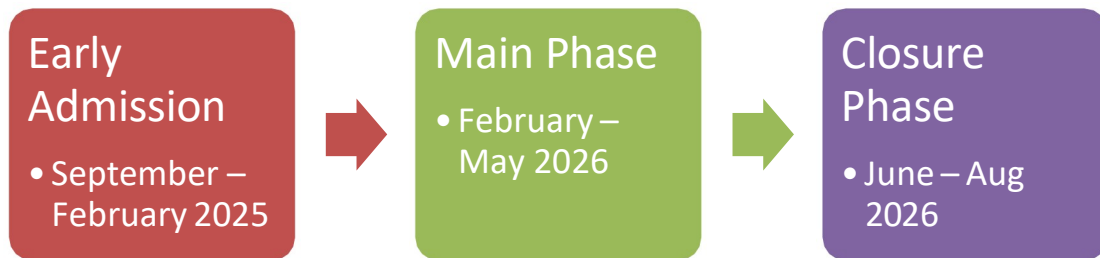

5.7 Acceptance of Offer:

- To secure the admission, the students are required to accept the offer within fifteen days of receiving the offer letter. This acceptance is confirmed **by paying the registration fee of Rs. 1,00,000 (out of which Rs. 25,000 is for the welcome kit, which is non-refundable)**, and serves as an official confirmation of the student's intent to enroll at the university.
- On receipt of the registration fee, a welcome kit will be dispatched to the student, with formal intimation from Registrar's Office.

6. ADMISSION POLICY

- Admission Policies of specific programs offered by schools and as approved by the Board of Management (BOM) may have program-specific criteria. In such a case, the policy as specified in the specific programs admission document shall prevail.
- Admission to VU will be as per the phases mentioned below;



- VU offers various types of annual scholarships – (i) Armed forces scholarship, (ii) Merit-based Economic Weaker Section (EWS) Scholarship. These are mutually exclusive. All scholarships are given annually. The student will have to maintain academic achievements and conduct to maintain continuance of a scholarship. (as specified by VU from time to time)
- To avail these scholarships, the student will mandatorily be required to express interest in availing financial aid whilst filling the form and must have successfully gone through the admission process and has been admitted. These scholarships will be granted basis the score on the VUSAT and the ASP recommendation of the panel as well as other conditions as stipulated for each type of a scholarship.
- The Registrar office will have the exclusive right to revoke the scholarship if the student is unable to provide the evidence of the merit, the economic status, the required documents. Vijaybhoomi University also retains the right to revoke such scholarships at any point of time. In case Vijaybhoomi University does exercise its rights to revoke such scholarship, the university will provide an adequate opportunity to generate the required resources or get admission into another University/Institution. In such circumstances VU shall provide a transcript to the new University along with a transfer of credit certificate.

7. EVALUATION PROCESS FOR LIBERAL BACHELOR'S PROGRAM

Every aspirant will need to write the prescribed entrance test (VUSAT) and attain the prescribed eligible score and appear for the Admission Selection Process (ASP) to become eligible for admission at Vijaybhoomi University. The evaluation will be done as per the following steps:

- The aspirant will need to write the prescribed entrance test and attain the eligibility score as prescribed by the Admissions Committee. This will need to be recorded in a table illustrated below

- Further after attaining the eligibility score the aspirant will be invited to appear for the ASP and the final decision of admission will arrive by computing a composite score of three objective parameters in proportion to the weights listed below:

PARAMETERS
1. Aptitude Grade (VUSAT)/ Music or Design Portfolio
2. Academic Grade
3. Personal Interview (PI) Grade

- During the PI the aspirant will also be evaluated subjectively by the ASP Panelists and the Panelists will provide their recommendation as explained here under.
- The final selection of the students will be based on the combination of the three objectives and one subjective criterion as described below.

7.1 APTITUDE GRADE – 30%

The Aptitude Grade will be computed by taking the best scores obtained by the aspirant in the prescribed entrance test as per the table given below

For e.g. A candidate scoring above 70% in the VUSAT will be assigned a grade point of 8 (G). A candidate is required to attain a minimum 40 percent marks in the VUSAT.

7.2 ACADEMIC GRADE – 20% WEIGHTAGE

The Academic Grade shall be computed based on the scores obtained by the aspirant in their 10th Grade as follows:

A. For Indian Board Examinations Offering Marks and Percentages

For e.g. a candidate scoring 91% will be assigned a grade point of 10 (E)

- For IGCSE Board Marks, the following table need to be used for converting grades to percentages and the Grade Points based on the computed percentages can be assigned using the table for Indian Board Examinations. In case Percentage Uniform Marks (PUM) are not provided in the grade sheet, the overall percentage will need to be computed by converting grade obtained in each of the course into percentage value as mentioned in this table and then using the sum of percentages divided by the total number of courses to arrive at the overall percentage. Else use the PUM to compute the overall percentage.

7.3 PERSONAL INTERVIEW (PI) GRADE – 50% WEIGHTAGE

Each panelist will be required to assess the following competencies of the candidate through questioning.

Each panelist will be required to grade each of the above competency as Excellent / Good / Satisfactory / Unsatisfactory. These grades will then be converted to Grade Points as per the table below:-

Grades	Description	Points

The Grade Points of each panelist across each competency will be averaged and then a Composite grade point PI Score will be computed using the weights mentioned in the table above.

For e.g. assuming that there are three panelists and their competency assessment is as follows.

The composite Grade Point Score will be computed as follows

$$50\% \text{ of } (10+8+10)/3 + 30\% \text{ of } (8+6+6)/3 + 20\% \text{ of } (6+6+8)/3 = 4.67+2+1.33 = 8$$

The Aptitude, Academic and PI Grades Points will then be used to compute the Final ASP score using the weights as mentioned in the table below.

For e.g. using the same Grade Points of each example mentioned herein above the composite ASP Score will work out to be will end up with an ASP Score of 30% of 8 + 20% of 10 + 50% of 7 = 7.9

Aptitude Grade– 8 (G)

Academic Grade – 10 (E)

PI Grade – 7 (G)

In addition to the four components above each ASP Panelist will be required to provide a degree of recommendation (as listed below) based on their respective personal assessment of the aspirant:

8. SELECTION PROCESS FOR THE PROGRAM

1. A candidate meeting the following conditions would be eligible for the admission offer:
 - a. Secured eligibility score for the prescribed entrance test.
 - b. Obtained greater than 5 ASP Score.
 - c. Obtained not more than 1 NR by the ASP Panel
2. The offer letter format is attached in the annexure. Offer letters for all undergraduate courses at VU will be issued by the Registrar office at VU.
3. The candidates will be required to pay a non-refundable Registration and Admission Fee within five working days to reserve the seat for the candidate till the next milestone. The University will not be liable to guarantee a reserved seat to the candidate if the candidate fails to make the Registration/Admission fee on time.
4. On payment of non-refundable Registration Fee, the provisional Admission Letter will be issued subject to seat availability.
5. Provisional admission should at no time exceed the total number of seats.
6. On furnishing the senior higher secondary or XII Grade or any other equivalent examination marks demonstrating minimum eligibility for VU undergraduate programs and proof of payment of fee for the first year, the final admission letter will be issued from the Office of the Registrar.
7. The students will have the opportunity to avail the Education loan facilities from various Banks and financial institutions, to which the University admissions team will extend the necessary guidance and support.
8. The fee payment in instalment options (payable for each term / quarterly basis) can be considered by the University on case-by-case basis, depending upon the request made by the parents and students.

9. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- a) Recommended for 100% Scholarship (Armed forces– Martyrs) for the entire degree duration.
- b) Recommended for 100% Scholarship (EWS) for the entire degree duration
- c) Recommended for 25% Scholarship (Armed forces -serving/retired) for the entire degree duration.
- d) Recommended Dean's Merit Scholarship for UG and PG program up to 25 percent or 50 percent for the entire degree duration.
- e) Recommended Zubeen Garg Performance Scholarship for Music programs up to 25 percent or 50 percent for the entire degree duration.
- f) Recommended Principal's Recommendation Scholarship for UG and PG program up to 50 percent on the 1st year tuition fees.

Scholarships will be awarded based on their merit/economic/armed forces/performance status, their performance in VUSAT and the ASP. However, all candidates shall be required to complete the Admission Selection Process as mentioned above before being eligible for any scholarship. Only applicants prior to the dates of closure for the scholarship window will be eligible for the scholarships.

Note 1: *These scholarships will not be available for students who are applying for the International/Global Programs, International Pathway Programs.*

Note 2: *These scholarships cannot be clubbed with any other scholarship/In-State concession offered by Vijaybhoomi University.*

9.1 RECOMMENDED FOR 100% SCHOLARSHIP (ARMED FORCES– MARTYRS)

1. This scholarship will be awarded on a first cum first basis to wards of parents who were employed by the Armed Forces i.e. Army, Airforce and the Navy.
2. This scholarship will be 100% of the total tuition fee as applicable to wards of martyrs (Non-Refundable Registration fees as per the fee plan will be payable).
3. To earn this, a candidate should have undergone the VU selection process and earned qualifying marks prescribed for the merit scholarships and have been recommended by the panel members in the ASP for both admissions and scholarship. For the grant of scholarship, a candidate must secure the prescribed qualifying marks, as approved by the Academic Council of the University.

4. The student will have to score 7 CGPA every year for the continuation of the scholarship.

9.2 RECOMMENDED FOR 100% SCHOLARSHIP (EWS)

- A total 5% of the Total Number of Enrolled students of any individual school of Vijaybhoomi University under this category are earmarked for candidates belonging to the Economic Weaker Section (EWS).
- This scholarship will be 100 percent and will cover the tuition fee (Non- Refundable Registration fees as per the fee plan will be payable). Applicable hostel fee shall be payable.

To avail this scholarship the following criteria shall be observed:

1. The family income of the candidate should not be more than Rs 8,00,000 (Rupees Eight Lacs), as submitted per the last ITR.
2. The candidate should have undergone the VU selection process and earned qualifying marks prescribed for these scholarships and have been recommended by the ASP panel and approved by the Dean.
3. For grant of scholarship, a candidate must secure the prescribed qualifying good marks, as approved by the Academic Council of the University.
4. The student will have to score 7 CGPA every year for the continuation of the scholarship.

9.3 RECOMMENDED FOR 25% SCHOLARSHIP (ARMED FORCES SERVING/RETIRED)

- The total number of Armed forces- Serving/Retired scholarships have been fixed up to 5% of the Total Number of Enrolled students of any individual school of Vijaybhoomi University
- This scholarship will be awarded on a first cum first basis to wards of parents who are/were employed and are serving/retired by the Defense Services i.e. Army, Airforce and the Navy.
- This scholarship will be 25% of the total tuition fee (Non- Refundable Registration fees as per the fee plan will be payable).
- To earn this, a candidate should have undergone the VU selection process and earned qualifying marks prescribed for this scholarship and have been recommended by the panel members in the ASP for both admissions and scholarship. For the grant of scholarship, a candidate must secure the prescribed qualifying marks, as approved by the Academic Council.
- The student will have to score 7 CGPA every year for the continuation of the scholarship.

9.4 RECOMMENDED DEAN'S MERIT/ PERFORMANCE/ ZUBEEN GARG PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP

- The total number of merit-based scholarship have been fixed up to 5 % of the Total Number of Enrolled students at any individual school of Vijaybhoomi University.
- In case of Merit/ Performance Scholarship for UG/ PG programs, the aggregate percentage of Class 12th / UG in Year 2026 will be calculated. These subjects will be considered for respective / selected disciplines. No rounding off shall be done for calculation of the percentage. This scholarship shall not be given to a candidate having any backlog at the time of admission. Students having grades instead of marks in qualifying exam, the University shall convert their grades into marks using its own rules.
- This scholarship up to 25% or 50 % as per the recommendation of the ASP Panel/ Dean (please refer the table in Appendix I). The scholarship will be awarded to the First-Year tuition fee. Non- Refundable Registration fees as per the feel plan will be payable.

10. Special Tuition Fee

DOMICILE BASED SPECIAL TUITION FEE FOR IN-STATE CANDIDATES FROM THE STATE OF MAHARASHTRA OR CANDIDATES FROM DIFFICULT TERRAINS OF JAMMU & KASHMIR AND NORTHEASTERN STATES OF INDIA

- 20% of the Total Number of Enrolled students of the Vijaybhoomi University shall be reserved for students who are domiciled in Maharashtra/ J&K/ NE States.
- Students availing the instate status will not be permitted to participate in the scholarships as listed.
- The application period for in-state students will close on July 15, 2026. Following this date, in-state students may continue to apply under the standard category until the final admission deadline.

To establish in-state status, the student will have to meet the following criteria,

Anyone of the following listed documents shall be accepted to establish the domicile:

- i. SSC Xth Marksheet and HSC XIIth Marksheet from Maharashtra/ J&K/ NE State board.
- ii. Domicile/Birth/Leaving Certificate of candidate Indicating place of Birth In the state of Maharashtra/ J&K/ NE State.
- iii. A letter from your School or Junior College located in Maharashtra/ J&K/ NE State certifying that you have been a student of the institution for the past 5 years.

An established In-State/ NER Student will be entitled to receive education at Vijaybhoomi University at a special fee which is 75% of the normal credit fee. The special fee shall be applicable only to the Tuition fee. All other fees will be charged as per normal charges.

Hostel Terms and Conditions: -

- 1) The hostel fee includes food, air-conditioned accommodation, and internet access.
- 2) The First-Year hostel fee has to be paid in advance for the entire academic year two months prior to the new registration date in order to secure on-campus accommodation.
- 3) Hostel fee will not be prorated based on number of days, is non-refundable and payable for one academic year in advance.
- 4) Hostel rooms are air conditioned and are allotted on a 4-sharing basis. Each room is equipped with an Integrated Unit consisting of a bed, study table and storage space for each inmate.
- 5) Allocation of beds is done through a lottery system.
- 6) Hostel fee includes lodging and boarding charges for on academic year. The boarding facilities consists of breakfast, lunch, and dinner during the stay on campus. Charges on meals skipped by students are not refundable or adjustable.

The Committee shall be responsible for:
